**For Handicap & One-Design Fleets to be held at Marina del Rey
Sunday, July 12, 2009**

1 RULES

This Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2009-2012*.

2 ENTRIES

- 2.1 This regatta is open to current members of PHRF, One Design, and Cruising classes.
- 2.2 Each entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, racing a boat which is registered in the class or fleet in which it competes.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form available at www.mvyc.org and emailing completed form to rgreen@ca.rr.com (entry fee due on day of race) or at the drop box at the front door MVYC, located on the G-2 level of the West Tower of the Marina City Club, 4333 Admiralty Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.
- 2.4 Completed entry forms and fees (payable to MVYC) will be accepted at the MVYC drop box until 1700 hours Friday, July 10, 2009

3 CLASSES:

Classes will be established for PHRF, One-Design, Sport Boat and Cruising fleets, with a minimum of four entries, based on entries received by 1700 hours on Friday, July 10, 2009.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1 Three races are scheduled for One-Design, Sport Boat and PHRF classes, and two races are scheduled for the Cruising Class.
- 3.2 The warning signal for the first start will be at 1155
- 3.3 Subsequent races will start as soon as possible after the finish of the preceding race.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at the MVYC drop box and at www.mvyc.org by 1700 hours July 10, 2009

5 COURSES

Courses will be selected from the Marina Del Rey Course Chart 16.

6 PENALTIES

The two turns penalty is modified to one turn including one tack and one gybe. This changes **RRS 44.2**.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 No race score will be excluded.
- 7.2 Two races must be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.3 The Cruising fleet will use ratings based on the ASMBYC Cruiser Fleet rating worksheet, which is available at the MVYC drop box and at www.mvyc.org.

8.0 PRIZES:

The Dr. Robert Baker Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the boat with the best overall performance.

Take home trophies will be given as follows:

4 boats	- 1 trophy	7-10 boats	- 3 trophies
5-6 boats	- 2 trophies	11+ boats	- 4 trophies

Additional prizes will be given to the boat with the best performance in "Women On The Water" (all women crew), "Woman at the Helm" ("WAH"; mixed crew) Performance, and WAH Cruising.

The Chuck Stein Trophy will be awarded to the boat with the best performance in the series.

RACE ENTRY AGREEMENT with Marina Venice Yacht Club and Pacific Mariners Yacht Club:

I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern this event, including USCG requirements, class rules and fleet rules whose rating system will be used for the races in which I compete.

By listing a Handicap rating, I certify that I hold a valid certificate for that rating for this season; or by entering a one-design class, I certify that I qualify under the class rules. Any contestant or any member of the race or protest committee may inspect my boat before or after the race.

I hereby release MVYC and PMYC, together with their officers, agents, employees and committees from any and all liability for any injury to myself, my crew or my boat arising out of their conduct of the race or use of the facilities, provided that such release does not discharge my insurance carrier under the provisions of insurance policies on my boat. This waiver shall not be deemed as any indemnity on my part.

I assume any risk of injury arising out of my participation in the race, failure or breakage of my boat or any of my equipment, or weather conditions. I acknowledge that the safety and seaworthiness of my boat, and the decision to race or keep racing, is my sole responsibility and SBYRC/MVYC, in accepting my entry, assumes no responsibility therefore. I will notify the Race Committee promptly upon withdrawal from the race. I certify that my crew and I are able to swim. I own or have chartered the boat entered, and I am a member of a Yacht Club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing.
